Dear Coconino County Fair Junior Exhibitor,

The Coconino County Fair has made the decision to adjust the minimum weight for junior swine exhibits. **The swine minimum weight will be 225 lbs. for the 2023 Fair.** Animals that do not make weight may be shown in showmanship and feeder classes only and may be sold from the barn, not through the auction.

Animals not eligible to sell through the auction may sell out of the barns immediately following the auction. The Northern Arizona Junior Livestock Association (NAJLA) has graciously offered to make an announcement at the conclusion of the auction to tell buyers that additional exhibits are available for sale in certain barns. No animal exhibit, whether as part of 4-H/FFA or Open, may be advertised for sale prior to the conclusion of the auction. Fair Superintendents will have supplies and lend assistance for advertising your exhibit for sale. Please consult with them prior to posting anything in the barn.

Once available, the 2023 Fair Book and entry registration will be at CoconinoCountyFair.com/Entries. Information and registration on the Junior Livestock Auction will be available at najlasite.org.
